Article 5.1: Composition of Crew

The term 'Car' refers to the registered crew member or members taking part in this event. Registration can be for one person or two in the same household.

Article 6.1: Entry Applications

Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis to those competitors who have completed the entry form in full and paid.

Article 6.2: Maximum and Minimum Number of Entries

For this event there are no maximum or minimum number of entries.

Article 7.2: Refund of Entry Fees

Cancellation Policy – If cancelled in writing prior to 6th March 2021 the entry will be refunded in full, a no show or cancellation after the 6th March 2021 will not be eligible for any refund.

Article 11.3: Maps

Maps are not required. All maps required will be sent via email on Sunday 7th March, it is recommended that you print these maps for ease of use, before starting any of the online sessions.

Article 16.2: General Procedure

This rally consists of eight regularities split into two timed sessions. You can complete the sessions at any time between 10:00 Sunday 7th March and 23:59 Sunday 14th March, however once a session has started it must be completed in one go, and both must be submitted before 23:59 Sunday 14th March to make the leader board.

Plot each regularity on the maps provided and answer the questions correctly to move onto the next challenge, incorrect answers will take you to hints and tips to help you find your way but will take a little longer.
