### Article 1.1: Definition and Status

These Additional Supplementary Regulations (ASRs) must be read in conjunction with the 2024 HERO Standard Regulations (HSRs). The article numbers are those of the HSRs. Competitors must study the HSRs as well as these ASRs. (Note: Any amendments to the 2024 HSRs will be advised in Bulletin 1)

**The 2024 version of the HSRs will be found on the Event page from January 2024.**

The Summer Trial will be run by HERO-ERA under a Clubman Historic Road Rally Permit (no. TBA) issued by Motorsport UK and is open only to members of the promoting club in compliance with the Regulations of Motorsport UK in compliance with the FIVA International Sport Code; the HSRs; these ASRs; and further Bulletins for the event, which may amend these ASRs and the HSRs.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** All motor sport is potentially dangerous. The onus is on competitors to drive carefully and safely at all times. The Organisers accept no responsibility whatsoever for any accident or injury befalling competitors, and do not undertake to provide rescue or assistance of any kind. All competitors will be required to sign the indemnity at Signing On.

### **Article 3: Eligible Vehicles**

**Please note that in some cases it will be necessary for us to apply for waivers if your car is registered after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1968.**

In order that we may apply for the waivers on your behalf, could you please supply the following information:

- Three photos – one general exterior view, one internal view and one of the engine bay.
- A copy of the vehicle registration document. If your vehicle has been imported it will be necessary for you to provide a copy of documentation that confirms the original build date of the car.

Once we have received the above, we will be able to confirm whether or not additional photos or other information is required before we are able to process the application for waivers.

### **Article 3.2: Classes**

Competing vehicles will be divided into five categories. These categories may then be split into classes to provide the best competition between crews and may include criteria for body style, cubic capacity and design age.

The provisional list of category and classes is as follows:

Category 1 – Cars of a specification valid before 1<sup>st</sup> January 1968

Category 2 – Cars of a specification valid between 1<sup>st</sup> January 1968 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 1974

Category 3 – Cars of a specification valid between 1<sup>st</sup> January 1975 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 1981

Category 4(a) – Cars of a specification valid between 1<sup>st</sup> January 1982 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 1985

Category 4(b) - Cars of a specification valid between 1<sup>st</sup> January 1986 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 1990

Category 5 – Masters – 10 Masters Entries will be accepted once the Entry list opens any further Masters Entries will only be accepted 28 days prior to the event, and only when entries are still available not taken up by Non Masters Crews

Categories may be merged if there are insufficient cars entered in any one category or class.

All vehicles must be taxed and insured for the public highway. They must further comply with MSA Technical Regulations and in particular with J5 and R19.1.

**The Definition of Master's Class** – A Master will be defined by a crew member who has finished first overall on three or more HERO-ERA Green or Blue standard events or, in the top three of a Red or Black event in the preceding five years. This is extended to include finishing positions in non-overall award eligible cars on certain other HERO-ERA events. In addition, crew members who have received a Le Jog Gold medal or have finished first overall in a HRCR National B/Inter Club Road Rally in the preceding three years will also be classified as Masters.

Classification relates to the seat in which an individual has entered and the status of a crew at the beginning of a season will remain in force for the duration of that season irrespective of their results during the year.

If both entrants are defined as Masters they will be designated in the Masters Class on that event and cannot compete for Overall or Class Awards. A Master Driver or Navigator can compete with a non-master Navigator or Driver and will be eligible for overall awards but Masters will not be eligible for points in the Hero Challenge Championship or for Clock Watcher or Test Pilot Awards if earned in the seat for which they are categorised as a Master. The type and category of car entered has no bearing on the crew's status as the definition of a Master is purely based upon their experience and results.

## **Article 5.2 – Eligible Competitors – Licences**

**For UK Residents** - As for all events run in the UK by HERO-ERA in 2024 and beyond, all competitors whether you're a driver or a navigator are required to have a Current Motorsport UK Competition licence (or a Competition Licence issued by your country's governing body). If you don't hold such a licence then you must apply for an RS Clubman licence. This licence is free of charge and can be obtained by going online to the Motorsport UK site and making a formal application. If you held a 2023 Licence you will need to renew it for 2024.

You will then be issued with a competition licence which will give you your competition licence number. You will also need to bring the competition licence with you for inspection at signing on or if you have a temporary number please bring the email confirmation.

Should you require any assistance regarding this, then please do not hesitate to contact the office who will give you any guidance they can.

**For Non-UK Residents** – Any Non-UK resident that does not hold a competition licence issued by the motorsport governing body of their native country can apply for a Motorsport UK RS Clubman licence. This exercise must be completed before the event so that competitors can bring the UK licence to the start venue.

## **Article 6.1: Entry Applications**

Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis to those competitors who have completed the entry form in full and paid the deposit. If full payment isn't received by the closing date then the place will be offered to the first reserve on the waiting list.

## **Article 6.2: Maximum and Minimum Number of Entries**

The maximum number of entries allowed to take part will be 80, the minimum will be 45.

## Article 7.2: Refund of Entry Fees

Cancellation Policy – If cancelled in writing prior to 10<sup>th</sup> April 2024 (100 days prior) all payments made will be returned apart from the NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of £375. If cancelled on or after 10<sup>th</sup> April but before 30<sup>th</sup> May 2024 (50 days prior), then 60% of the entry fee will be retained. On or after 30<sup>th</sup> May 2024, no refunds or transfer will be possible as 98-100% of the events costs have been paid or committed.

We advise that you take out your own event cancellation insurance cover.

#### **Article 26: Insurance**

The Organisers have applied for a Blanket Certificate of Insurance to provide competitors who wish to use the scheme with third party cover to meet Road Traffic Act requirements on the road sections of the event.

The premium will be £39. This premium should be paid in cash at Documentation.

All competitors who will be driving on the event will be asked to sign an insurance declaration that they have cover for Road Traffic Act requirements, and to confirm that all drivers, either (a) are covered by an extension to private motor insurance to include cover whilst participating in the event; or (b) are able to comply with the following declaration.

#### **INSURANCE DECLARATION**

Vehicles must have a valid motor insurance policy which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be either, by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover, provided under the Event Road Section Scheme as an adjunct to an existing motor policy. If a competitor has an extension to their existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to purchase additional Road Section cover via the organisers, then they can do so prior to the event providing they comply with the following: **Is aged 19 years or over**

**Has held a full UK/EU driving licence for a minimum of 6 months Has no more than 6 conviction points on their licence and no bans of any kind Has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years Do not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motor policy The vehicle has a valid MOT and is taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so**

Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25.

Any competitor who falls outside these parameters may be offered cover at equivalent terms or an agreed price, if approval from the Appointed Insurance Broker has been obtained by the event organisers, prior to the event. Approval can be sought by Event Organisers sending an email to [contact@reis.co.uk](mailto:contact@reis.co.uk) and providing the Driver's name and date of birth, the date they passed their driving test and full details of any motoring claims and/or convictions.

Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the vehicle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s). Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded, excluded or retire from the event.
